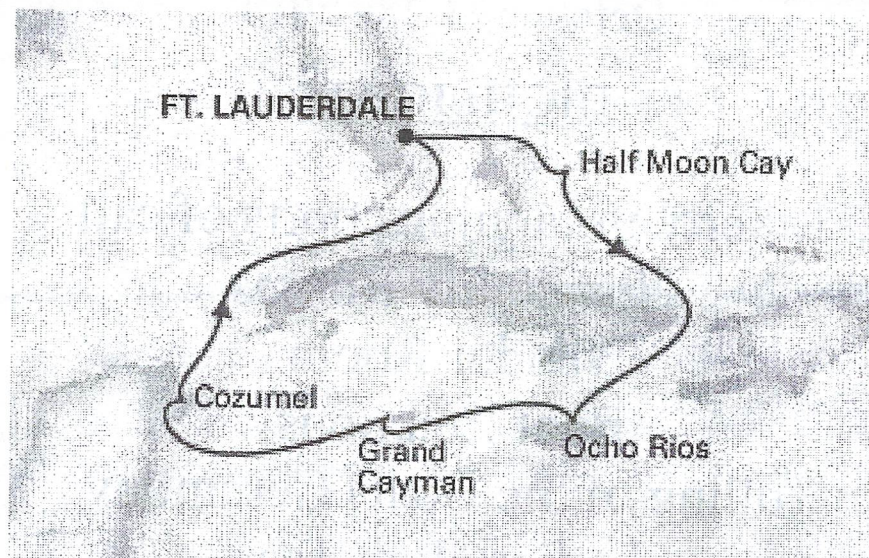

PORT CHARGES ARE INCLUDED in the above prices, however government fees, fuel surcharges, and taxes *estimated* at \$145 per person are additional. Rates are per person, cruise only.

(TAXES SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE)

Registration will be \$25.00 for members and \$15.00 for guests payable with initial deposit.

Other items not covered in the cruise cost are items of a personal nature such as photographs, laundry, massage, as well as shore excursions, alcoholic beverages, sodas, or tipping. Holland America applies a service charge for tipping to your account on board at the rate of at least \$13.50-\$15.50 per guest per day. All service personnel on board receive gratuities from this service charge, so no additional tipping is necessary except for bar drinks and spa services which have "as-you-go" service charges added separately.

DRESS

Being casual and comfortable is a part of life on the *ms Nieuw Amsterdam*. Weather in the Caribbean can be hot during the daytime, yet cool in the evening— You may need a light jacket for both cool weather and potential rain. The temperature in each cabin is individually controlled for your own comfort. Bring comfortable shoes to wear in port, streets are often uneven or rough. There are Two formal nights (black tie not required, but suit and tie for gents), and other nights are smart casual nights no jeans or T-shirts in the dining room). If you don't want to participate in the formal nights, you have the option of dining casually on the Lido deck.

TRAVEL TO AND FROM FT. LAUDERDALE

We can arrange airline tickets and other personalized travel. We are able to quote fares for all airlines and look for the best prices. Transfers from the airport to the cruise ship and back are available at a minimal charge. Pre and post-cruise packages are available at an additional cost for those who would like to arrive in Ft. Lauderdale a day or two early, or stay after the cruise. We will offer custom hotel packages and touring both before and after the cruise; those details will be mailed to you at a later date. We will also have a list of RV parking sites.

PAYMENTS

A deposit of \$350 per person is needed to guarantee your reservation.. Final payment will be due no later than July 01, 2018. Payments may be made by check (payable to AAA Travel), or by major credit card.

CANCELLATIONS

The cancellation policy is as follows:

From 75 days to 46 days prior to the cruise: 50% of the fare per person non-refundable

From 45 days to 16 days prior to the cruise: 75% of the fare per person non-refundable

There is no refund within 15 days of sailing.

THE PURCHASE OF TRIP CANCELLATION, TRAVEL ACCIDENT, AND BAGGAGE INSURANCE IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.

There are many uncertainties and unforeseen circumstances involved in our world, we therefore strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance. This provides coverage in the event prepaid payments are forfeited due to your trip having to be canceled because of unforeseeable sickness, injury or death to you, a family member, or a traveling companion. It also provides coverage if there were to be a default on the part of the cruise line. In addition, it will provide coverage for travel accidents, baggage loss or damage, and medical evacuation. This insurance coverage is available at a rate which varies by your age and the cost of your cruise. FOR SPECIFIC RATE INFORMATION, PLEASE SEE THE TravelGuard flyer which is enclosed. You will be completely covered, waiving all pre-existing conditions, only if the insurance is purchased at the time of deposit. Please complete the section on the registration form regarding insurance.

We cannot accept your registration unless this is completed and signed.

IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS

A passport that is valid for at least six months beyond your return date is required for travel. Non-US citizens must have a valid passport and any necessary visas. Legal names must be correct on all documents. Lack of proper ID will result in denial of embarkation, therefore all passengers are responsible for necessary identification. Travel Insurance Coverage

100% of Trip Cost Trip Cancellation/150% of Trip Cost Trip Interruption: Reimburses prepaid, non-refundable expenses if you must cancel or interrupt your Trip due to Unforeseen:

- Sickness, injury, or death of you, a Family Member, Traveling Companion, Business Partner or Host at Destination. Injury or Sickness must be so disabling as to reasonably cause a Trip to be canceled or interrupted;
- Financial Default of an airline, cruise line, or tour operator. This coverage applies only if: (1) you purchased this coverage within 15 days of initial trip payment; and (2) the Financial Default occurs more than 14 days after your coverage effective date;
- Inclement weather causing delay or cancellation of travel;
- Strike resulting in the complete cessation of travel services at the point of departure or Destination;
- The Insured's Primary Residence being made Uninhabitable or Inaccessible by Natural Disaster, vandalism, or burglary;
- The Insured's Destination being made Uninhabitable or Inaccessible by a flood, tornado, earthquake, fire, wildfire, volcanic eruption, or blizzard that is due to natural causes;
- You or your Traveling Companion being subpoenaed, required to serve on a jury, hijacked, or quarantined;
- You or your Traveling Companion being called into active military service or having leave revoked or being reassigned;
- A Terrorist Incident in a City listed on your itinerary within 30 days of your scheduled arrival;
- The Insured or Traveling Companion is involuntarily terminated or laid off, provided that he or she has been an active employee for the same employer for at least one year. Termination must occur following the effective date of coverage. This provision is not applicable to temporary employment, independent contractors or self-employed persons;
- You or your Traveling Companion is directly involved in or delayed due to a traffic accident en route to Destination;
- A named hurricane causing cancellation of travel to the Insured's Destination that is Inaccessible or Uninhabitable. The Company will only pay benefits for losses occurring within 30 calendar days after the named hurricane makes the Insured's Destination Inaccessible or Uninhabitable. Benefits are not payable if a hurricane is named on or before the effective date of the Insured's Trip Cancellation coverage;
- You or your Traveling Companion being the victim of a Felonious Assault within 10 days prior to the Departure Date;
- Mechanical/equipment failure of a Common Carrier that occurs on a scheduled Trip and causes complete cessation of the Insured's travel and results in a loss of 50% of the Insured's Trip length;
- You or your Traveling Companion is required to work during his/her scheduled Trip. He/she must provide proof of requirement to work, such as a notarized statement signed by an officer of his/her employer;
- You or your Traveling Companion is directly involved in a merger, acquisition, government required product recall, or bankruptcy proceedings and must be currently employed by the company that is involved in said event;
- Your or your Traveling Companion's company is deemed to be unsuitable for business due to burglary or Natural Disaster, and the Insured or Traveling Companion is directly involved as a Key Employee of the disaster recovery team.

\$1,000 Trip Interruption — Return Air Only: Reimburses the additional transportation expenses incurred by you to reach the return destination for Trip Interruptions due to one of the Unforeseen events listed above. However, the benefit payable above will not exceed the cost of economy airfare (or same class of your original tickets) by the most direct route, less any refunds paid or payable.

General Exclusions: This plan does not cover any loss caused by or resulting from: (a) intentionally self-inflicted injury, suicide, or attempted suicide of the Insured, Family Member, Traveling Companion or Business Partner while sane or insane; (b) pregnancy, childbirth, or elective abortion, other than Complications of Pregnancy; (c) participation in professional athletic events, motor sport, or motor racing, including training or practice for the same; (d) mountaineering where ropes or guides are normally used. The ascent or descent of a mountain requiring the use of specialized equipment, including but not limited to pick-axes, anchors, bolts, crampons, carabineers, and lead or top-rope anchoring equipment; (e) war or act of war, whether declared or not, civil disorder, riot, or insurrection; (f) operating or learning to operate any aircraft, as student, pilot, or crew; (g) air travel on any air-supported device, other than a regularly scheduled airline or air charter company; (h) commission of or attempt to commit a felony by the Insured; (i) Mental, Nervous or Psychological Disorder; (j) if the Insured's tickets do not contain specific travel dates (open tickets); (k) being under the influence of drugs or narcotics, unless administered upon the advice of a Physician or intoxication above the legal limit; (l) any loss that occurs at a time when this coverage is not in effect; (m) traveling for the purpose of securing medical treatment; (n) any Trip taken outside the advice of a Physician.

PRE-EXISTING MEDICAL CONDITION EXCLUSION:
